The Milwaukee Brewers are our American professional baseball team. The team is named for the city's association with the brewing industry. Since 2001, the Brewers have played their home games at Miller Park, which has a seating capacity of 41,900.



The team's only World Series appearance came in 1982. After winning the ALCS against the California Angels, the Brewers faced off against the St. Louis Cardinals in the World Series, losing 4 -3. Maybe 2017 will be the year for the Brewers to return.

The Medford High School Baseball team will be playing a game at Miller Park this year. In order for this to happen, the team must sell a certain number of Brewer home game tickets. They are organizing a group outing to Miller Park for the game against the Miami Marlins on Saturday, July 1st. The game begins at 3:10 p.m. The seats are in section 109, rows 14 -22.
