In the lower level there is an antique milking parlor exhibit, complete with stanchions and names of memorable cows. The barn also contains a gift shoppe. The Milk House, set right next to the barn, provides for yet another shopping stop. Adorned with seasonal items, the restored Milk House is also an interesting place to visit.
